## QUESTIONS ASKED TODAY

*Notice Given**Wednesday, 16 March 2016***3889. Hon Lynn MacLaren to the Minister for Mental Health representing the Minister for Planning:**

Further to question without notice No. 31 asked on 15 May 2013, I ask:

- (a) was the Western Australian Planning Commission's (WAPC) contribution of \$250,000 to investigate the proposed Mangles Bay canal estate and marina derived from Metropolitan Region Improvement Tax funds allocated for Parks and Reserves;
- (b) if no to (a), from which specific WAPC funding source, allocated for what purpose, was the \$250,000 derived and how was this decision justified;
- (c) did the decision to make the \$250,000 available include the condition that the WAPC would be repaid and, if so, by whom and when;
- (d) who approved the decision to make the \$250,000 available for the marina; and
- (e) will the Minister please table, or if publicly available, refer me to the findings of the WAPC-funded investigation?

**3890. Hon Darren West to the Attorney General representing the Minister for Road Safety:**

- (1) As at 29 February 2016, had any member of the Western Australian Nationals made any request for the expenditure from the Road Trauma Trust Fund on dangerous country roads?
- (2) If yes to (1):
  - (a) who contacted the Minister for Road Safety;
  - (b) when did they contact the Minister; and
  - (c) will the Minister table a copy of any correspondence (email or letters) received from those listed in (2)(b)?

**3891. Hon Robin Chapple to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:**

- (1) Is the Minister aware that the Broome Port Authority developed a concept plan for a marina near Broome in the mid-2000s?
- (2) Is the Minister aware that according to media reports (<http://www.abc.net.au/news/2006-05-30/concept-plan-urges-entrance-pt-as-resort-site/1765832>) Entrance Point was suggested as a possible site for a multi-million dollar resort and safe harbour?
- (3) Is the Minister aware that media reports at the time stated that three sites, including Riddell Beach and Dampier Creek, were ruled out due to environmental, cultural and cost issues?
- (4) Will the Minister table the concept plan?
- (5) If no to (4), why not?
