3321. Hon Stephen Dawson to the Minister for Mental Health:

What are the latest figures held on the number of people in acute hospital beds that could be in supported community housing if a bed was available?

3322. Hon Stephen Dawson to the Minister for Mental Health:

From 1 July 2014 to 31 January 2015 there were 57 occasions when Armadale Hospital had to lock the doors of open wards because of the overflow of involuntary mental health patients from secure wards, and I ask:

- (a) are any statistics held on whether these closures were due to patients being affected by methamphetamine;
- (b) are statistics held on what the number of emergency department presentations were due to patients affected by methamphetamine; and
- (c) if yes to (b), will the Minister please provide numbers for the past three years?

3323. Hon Stephen Dawson to the Minister for Mental Health:

The *2012 Stokes Review* investigated 255 suicides and determined that 15 percent of men and 20 percent of women who took their own lives in Western Australia died within 24 hours of being discharged from a mental health facility and that one third took their own lives within a month, and I ask:

- (a) can the Minister please advise what the latest held suicide statistics are for Western Australians discharged from a mental health hospital in the day and month following this; and
- (b) if no to (a), why not?

3324. Hon Stephen Dawson to the Minister for Mental Health:

- (1) How many children have been treated for self-inflicted injuries at each West Australian paediatric hospital emergency department for each of the past five years?
- (2) How many children have been treated for behavioural disorders at each West Australian paediatric hospital emergency department for each of the past five years?

3325. Hon Kate Doust to the Minister for Education:

I refer to the 2015-16 State Budget, and I ask:

- (a) why was there no money allocated for a new high school in Jandakot; and
- (b) how does the Minister plan to deal with the dramatic increase in need for a high school in that area?
