- (b) as of 1 June 2014, how many of the applicants currently waiting on public housing in the Goldfields region identify as Aboriginal;
- (c) what immediate action has, or will be taken, by the Department of Housing regarding the Brown Avenue housing complex given that the Goldfields Indigenous Housing Association advised that it does not have capacity to manage the facility;
- (d) how long has the Department of Housing been aware that seven houses in the Brown Avenue complex are vacant; and
- (e) how quickly will the Department of Housing act to appoint tenants to the vacant properties in the Brown Avenue complex?
