*Notice Given**Wednesday, 13 February 2019***1873. Hon Robin Chapple to the Minister for Environment:**

I refer to a fire on the Burrup during November 2018, at the north end and for all of Dolphin Island that was caused by a lightning strike, and given the area has World Heritage Value and contains a million plus petroglyphs, I ask:

- (a) is the Minister aware that the department decided to let the fire burn without any restraint;
- (b) will the Minister explain why the decision was made by the department to let the fire burn without any restraint;
- (c) will the Minister advise if any of the Rock Art on the Burrup was damaged by the fire;
- (d) if the Rock Art was not damaged by the fire, will the Minister provide the evidence that demonstrates this to be true; and
- (e) if no to (d), why not?
