- (1) What was the total spend on safety initiatives for cyclists in 2015-2016?
- (2) Given that cyclists constituted four per cent of fatalities on Western Australian roads in 2014, will the Government commit four per cent of the overall funds available through the Road Trauma Trust Account to improving road safety for cyclists?

- (e) will the results of that groundwater study be made publicly available and an opportunity to respond to the results of that groundwater study be provided; and
