Dear Madam President

The *Financial Management Act 2006* (Act) requires the responsible Minister—the Treasurer—to review the 'operation and effectiveness' of that Act and table a report on that review in both Houses of Parliament. The 'Review of the Financial Management Act (2006) — December 2017 Report' was tabled in both Houses of Parliament on 27 June 2018. This is the second review of the Act.

The Joint Standing Committee on Audit (Committee) is now required to carry out a review of that report, under section 85(4) of the Act. The Committee's review will examine that report and have regard to any outstanding or relevant matters from the first review of the Act and the previous Committee's review of the operation and effectiveness of the Auditor General Act 2006.

The Committee requests that you inform the Council accordingly. I have written in similar terms to the Speaker of the Legislative Assembly.
