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## NON-GOVERNMENT BUSINESS

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### 1. Remote Aboriginal Communities

Hon Ken Travers to move —

That this House expresses concern at the Barnett Government's intention to close a number of remote Aboriginal communities, and calls on the Government to —

- (a) consult directly with the communities on their future; and
- (b) recognise that the size and geographic location of communities throughout regional Western Australia should not be the sole determinant of whether they receive State support.
