2. Statement by President — Computer Virus

The President made the following Statement —

I advise that late yesterday afternoon a computer virus penetrated Parliaments information technology network despite sophisticated fire wall virus protection. The IT staff have worked jointly with external IT specialists on a solution to return the network to normal operating status. I can advise that some services were restored about 10 minutes ago. While the Parliament's IT network was offline it affected a number of House operations, including Hansard publications, the preparation and processing of questions on notice and answers to questions on notice; in addition, Parliament House telephones and the building's paging system were nonoperational. I wish to thank all staff who have been working hard to restore full services to Members, the Chambers and Parliament House. I also thank Members for your patience
