I refer to the privatisation of practical driving tests for ancillary heavy rigid and heavy combination vehicles, and I ask:

- (a) how many contractors were testing drivers in the following financial years:
 - (i) 2013-2014;
 - (ii) 2014-2015; and
 - (iii) 2015-2016 to date;
- (b) how many tests did each contractor undertake in each of the financial years listed in (a)(i)-(iii);
- (c) where were each of the contractors located; and
- (d) how many drivers were tested in each of (a)(i)-(iii)?

3817. Hon Robin Chapple to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Energy:

I refer to question without notice No. 1242, asked in the Legislative Council on 22 October 2015 to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Energy, and given that in 2014 the State generated just 9.3 per cent of its energy needs from renewable capacity, and that the State Government owns much of Western Australia's generation assets through Synergy and Horizon Power, and I ask:

- (a) are there plans for Synergy and Horizon Power to increase their renewable generation capacity to meet the 20 per cent target set by the Federal Government;
- (b) if no to (a), why not;
- (c) if yes to (a), what is the nature of these plans and when will they be publicly available; and
- (d) if yes to (a), will the Minister please table these plans?

Can the Minister please provide the amount of times on average, each Homeswest property is inspected by the department, per year, for the following years:

- (a) 2008;
- (b) 2009;
- (c) 2010;
