5. Suspension of Standing Orders

 - (c) how taxpayers' money was placed at risk in the refurbishment process;
 - (d) the extent of the losses to taxpayers and ways to ameliorate any losses; and
 - (e) the commercial arrangements around the refurbishment process and which party bears responsibility for the losses.

(2) That the Select Committee report on its inquiry to the Legislative Assembly by Thursday, 26 September 2013.

- (2) That the Select Committee report on its inquiry to the Legislative Assembly by Thursday, 26 September 2013.
