- (1) What is the total area of sea bed which will be engulfed at the proposed Port Catherine Development?
  - (2) How much of this is proposed to be newly reclaimed land and how much of this reclaimed land is to be used predominantly for residential purposes?
  - (3) Can the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure advise whether the proposed Port Catherine Marina Structure Plan gives priority to coastal dependent developments over non-coastal dependent as required by section 3.2 of the Western Australian Planning Commission's Policy (WAPC) No. 6.1 'Country Coastal Planning Policy'?
  - (4) Can the Minister clarify whether private residential canal development proposals are considered to be 'coastal dependent developments', as defined in WAPC Policy No. 6.1, and does the Minister now propose to give priority to the development of such residential canal estates over the establishment of public recreation and amenity requirements either at Coogee, or more generally?
  - (5) As the WAPC is the proponent of the proposed Port Catherine canal development, can the Minister demonstrate that this proposal will generate a demonstrable net public benefit in both the short and long term, as required by section 5.1 of the WAPC's Draft Statement of Planning Policy - State Coastal Planning Policy?
