*Notice Given**Tuesday, 10 December 2013***682. Hon Darren West to the Minister for Mental Health representing the Minister for Environment:**

I refer to question on notice No. 1015 in the other place, and ask of the 49,950 hectares of post-clear felling regrowth karri available for wood production:

- (a) how many hectares date from clear felling conducted before selective logging was introduced in about 1940;
- (b) how much of the regrowth in (a) has been thinned;
- (c) how many hectares date from clear felling conducted after the practice was reintroduced in 1967; and
- (d) how much of the regrowth in (c) has been thinned?

- (d) if no to (a), will the Minister table the final version;
- (e) if yes to (a), is the document valid if it was not fully signed by the contracting parties; and
- (f) if no to (d), why not?

- (4) To date, which Western Australian companies are liable entities under the *Renewable Energy (Electricity) Act 2000*?

- (6) If the RET was lowered from its current amount, how would this affect renewable energy investment in Western Australia?
