*Notice Given**Wednesday, 24 August 2016***4321. Hon Adele Farina to the Minister for Planning representing the Minister for Health:**

I refer to the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (WA) Regulations 2010*, on the State Law Publisher website, which states that the regulations were amended on 1 June 2015, and I ask:

- (a) were these new regulations or amendments to the regulations considered by the Parliament of Western Australia, as required under section 7(2) and section 245(2) of the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (WA) Act 2010*;
- (b) were these amendments referred to the Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation for consideration prior to being incorporated into the regulations on 1 June 2015 and, if yes, when;
- (c) why were regulations adopted by the Victorian Parliament incorporated into the Western Australian regulations, contrary to the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (WA) Act 2010*;
- (d) will the Minister table or identify the new regulations or amendments incorporated into the Western Australian regulations on 1 June 2015; and
- (e) what action is the Minister taking to ensure his department complies with Western Australian legislative requirements?

4322. Hon Stephen Dawson to the Minister for Disability Services:

I refer to support for people with disability in Western Australia, and I ask:

- (a) does the Western Australian National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) fund functional assessments for eligibility to the scheme;
- (b) if no to (a), what measures are in place to ensure that Western Australians on low incomes who cannot afford assessments have equal access to the scheme, for example those adults on low incomes with a mental health disability or learning disorder;
- (c) the major federal community non-clinical psychosocial support programs, such as Personal Helpers and Mentors program and Partners in Recovery, are being transitioned to NDIS, as such will the Minister please advise:
 - (i) which State funded equivalent support programs are available in the trial site regions for people with psychosocial support needs who are not eligible for the Western Australian NDIS; and
 - (ii) how many people do each of the programs in (i), have the capacity to support each year; and
- (d) how many new people aged under 65, who are not eligible for the NDIS, have been declined access to the Home and Community Care program (HACC) services since HACC funding was transferred to the NDIS?
