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**1. Mineral Resources Rent Tax — Goods and Services Tax**

That this House —

- (a) congratulates the Federal Government on the abolition of the job destroying, anti-Western Australian mining tax, also known as the Mineral Resources Rent Tax; and
- (b) calls on the Federal Government to take urgent steps to abolish the current flawed system for the distribution of Goods and Services Tax (GST) revenue amongst the Australian states, and implement a new population-based system that provides Western Australia with its fair share of GST revenue.

That the *Firearms Amendment Regulations 2014* published in the *Gazette* on 17 June 2014 and tabled in the Legislative Council on 24 June 2014 under the *Firearms Act 1973*, be and are hereby disallowed. (Tabled paper 1586).

**4. Shire of Ashburton Fencing Local Law 2014 – Disallowance**

That, pursuant to recommendation of the Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation, the *Shire of Ashburton Fencing Local Law 2014* published in the *Gazette* on 11 April 2014 and tabled in the Legislative Council on 6 May 2014 under the *Dividing Fences Act 1961*, be and is hereby disallowed.
