That, pursuant to recommendation of the Joint Standing Committee on Delegated Legislation, the *Children's Court (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2013* published in the *Gazette* on 15 November 2013 and tabled in the Legislative Council on 20 November 2013 under the *Children's Court of Western Australia Act 1988*, be and are hereby disallowed. (Tabled paper 995).
