1. Meeting of Assembly

The Assembly met at 2.00 p.m. pursuant to adjournment.

The Speaker took the Chair.

2. Speaker's Statement – Retirement of the Clerk

The Speaker advised members that the Clerk of the Legislative Assembly, Mr Peter McHugh, had given notice of his retirement. Mr McHugh's last day of active service will be Friday, 9 October 2015, after which he will proceed on pre-retirement leave, with his retirement taking effect in 2016.

By the time he retires, Mr McHugh will have given more than 29 years' service to the Parliament of Western Australia, serving more than 26 years of that time as Clerk of the Legislative Assembly. The Speaker thanked Mr McHugh on behalf of all members in this Chamber for his leadership, guidance and advice over the years and for his significant and lasting contribution to the management and operation of the Legislative Assembly and to the Parliament of Western Australia.
