## 1. Meeting of Council

#### 2. Petitions

Hon Donna Faragher presented a petition from 4 709 residents of Western Australia requesting the Legislative Council support the introduction of mandatory gaol terms on people who use violence against public officers. (Tabled paper 3863).

Hon Simon O'Brien, by leave, presented a non-conforming petition from 393 residents of Western Australia requesting the Legislative Council oppose the export of containerised lead concentrate through the port of Fremantle. (Tabled paper 3864).
