I refer to the Western Australia Police North West Metropolitan District, and I ask:

- (a) how many complaints have been received by Western Australia Police regarding people selling drugs or houses being used to sell drugs in:
 - (i) 2015-16; and
 - (ii) 2016-17 to date;
- (b) how many people or homes were searched by Western Australia Police for drugs in:
 - (i) 2015-16; and
 - (ii) 2016-17 to date;
- (c) how many complaints have been received by Western Australia Police regarding people selling drugs or houses being used to sell drugs which have previously been subjected to searches by Western Australia Police in:
 - (i) 2015-16; and
 - (ii) 2016-17 to date;
- (d) does Western Australia Police collect the above statistics by suburb or by smaller areas within the district; and
- (e) if yes to (d), can the Minister provide these statistics?

4579. Hon Nigel Hallett to the Attorney General representing the Minister for Emergency Services:

- (1) I refer to the Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES), and I ask, could the Minister please advise how much it has spent over the past ten years on buildings for the following services:
 - (a) Career Fire and Rescue;
 - (b) Volunteer Fire and Rescue;
 - (c) State Emergency Services; and
 - (d) Fire and Emergency Service Units?
- (2) What was the source of funding for each of the building projects in (1)?
- (3) I note that the DFES has recently put out a tender for vehicle fleet replacements, how much funding is allocated out of emergency services levy for this procedure?
- (4) Given the findings of the Ferguson Report, in regards to offering the fleet vehicles back into the local and farming community (page 24, Opportunity 18), what has the Government done to progress this recommendation?
- (5) Can the Minister please explain what it is doing in regards to taking the vehicle fleet design away from the current city-centric control and enabling the rural and rural-urban interface zones to be able to have 'fit for purpose' off-road vehicles rather than what is being forced upon them in the current design?
