  - (ii) what percentage of dwellings in each suburb in the City of Armadale are Homeswest dwellings; and
  - (iii) please provide Homeswest/non-Homeswest density comparisons with all metropolitan suburbs;
- (c) of the people evicted from Homeswest properties in the City of Armadale, how many have now been rehoused in Homeswest properties in the City of Armadale; and
- (d) if a tenant is evicted from a Homeswest property, are they then placed at the bottom of the waiting list or do they leapfrog those who are currently at the top of the list?

**798. Mr P.C. Tinley to the Minister for Planning:**

I refer to the Minister's answers to Questions on Notice No. 202 and 8544, concerning the City of Fremantle's Taylor's College development, and I ask:

- (a) does the Minister agree that while the Minister stated that the earthworks plan that the Minister tabled in Parliament (Tabled Paper No. 5436) contains the floor levels of the existing abutting lots, it in fact does not;
- (b) if no to (a) from reading the tabled earthworks plan, could the Minister please state what the floor level is of lot 58, which is traversed by 3 contours;
- (c) is it the case that the contours do not in fact give an understanding of floor levels and that is why it is important to have the floor levels of existing lots when adjoining lots are proposed for development, so that in deciding whether to approve the plan, the local government can have genuine regard to factors such as those listed in part (c) of Question on Notice No. 202;
- (d) does the absence of information about the floor levels of existing lots, together with the adverse effect on the residents of the existing properties who were only expecting a 1.8 metre high wall as indicated in the structure plan, show that factors impacting on them such as those listed in part (c) of Question on Notice No. 202 were not considered by the City of Fremantle before the level of the land was raised by about 2 metres;
- (e) has the Minister confused a clause in the local planning scheme that states that the subdivision and development is to generally be in accordance with the structure plan, with the fundamental requirement of the scheme for a structure plan to conform with the requirements of the scheme prior to advertisement;

- (f) if no to (e), why has the Minister stated that a proposal for a pedestrian network must only generally comply with the scheme when advertised, when the scheme clearly states what is required in terms of a proposal for a pedestrian network and such a proposal is not contained in the Taylor's College structure plan;
- (g) while the Minister has concluded that due process occurred, is the Minister being asked a different set of questions when a representation is made to the Minister under Section 211 of the *Planning and Development Act 2005*, for example:

- (d) how many urgent and how many non-urgent patients are currently on the waitlist for an MRI scan;
- (e) what was the average wait time for urgent and a non-urgent patients for an MRI scan, on 31 May for the following years:
  - (i) 2008;
  - (ii) 2009;
  - (iii) 2010;
  - (iv) 2011;
  - (v) 2012; and
  - (vi) 2013;
- (f) since June 2012 how many public patients have been referred to private health providers for MRI scans, and what were the reasons for this;
- (g) for each MRI scan referred to a private health service provider what is the average cost to the Department of Health;

- (h) how many MRI scanners have been purchased since January 2008 for the Western Australian public health system;
- (i) what is the projected need for MRI Scanners in Western Australia for the next four years; and
- (j) does the Department plan to purchase any additional MRI Scanners in Western Australia in the next four years?

**801. Mr R.H. Cook to the Minister for Health:**

I refer to the schedule of fees for Home and Community Care services, and I ask, could the Minister please provide a breakdown of the schedule of fees in each of the following years:

- (a) 2008–2009;
- (b) 2009–2010;
- (c) 2010–2011;
- (d) 2011–2012; and
- (e) 2012–2013?

**802. Mr R.H. Cook to the Minister for Health:**

I refer to spending in children's health and ask the Minister:

- (a) what percentage of the 2010–2011, 2011–2012 and 2012–2013 health budgets was spent on children's health; and
- (b) please provide a breakdown of the above budgets for children's health?

**803. Mr R.H. Cook to the Minister for Health:**

I refer to the Emergency Department (ED) at Bunbury Hospital and I ask:

- (a) what is the current capacity of operating theatres available to ED patients at Bunbury Hospital;
- (b) what is the current capacity of all operating theatres at Bunbury Hospital;
- (c) what number of ED presentations have there been in the following years at Bunbury Hospital:
  - (i) 2010–2011;
  - (ii) 2011–2012; and
  - (iii) 2012–2013; and
- (d) what are the projected number of ED presentations in each of the following years:
  - (i) 2013–2014;
  - (ii) 2014–2015;
  - (iii) 2015–2016; and
  - (iv) 2016–2017?

**804. Mr R.H. Cook to the Minister for Health:**

I refer to ambulance ramping in the Western Australian Country Health Service, and I ask, will the Minister please provide a breakdown of any ambulance ramping, by hospital and by month from January 2011 to June 2013?

**805. Mr D.J. Kelly to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Child Protection:**

For the financial year 2012–2013, for the North, South, East Metropolitan, Agricultural, Mining and Pastoral and South West regions, I ask:

- (a) how many applications for the Hardship Utility Grant Scheme (HUGS) have been received from Water Corporation customers; and
- (b) how many HUGS applications from Water Corporation customers were approved?

- (e) how many people have signed up to My Water to date; and
- (f) what performance measures have been established to evaluate the success of this website and have they been met to date?

**807. Mr D.J. Kelly to the Minister for Water:**

I refer to the H2O Assist program and I ask:

- (a) how much has been spent on this program in the following categories:
  - (i) publicity;
  - (ii) administration;
  - (iii) subsidising actual products; and
  - (iv) other costs;
- (b) how much is budgeted to be spent on this program this financial year;
- (c) how many of each product has been purchased through the program;
- (d) how much water has been saved to date;
- (e) how much water is estimated to be saved annually by this program;
- (f) what performance measures have been put in place for this program and have they been met to date; and
- (g) how was the private sector provider chosen for this program?

**808. Mr D.J. Kelly to the Minister for Water:**

For the financial year 2012–2013 to date, for the North, South, East Metropolitan, Agricultural, Mining and Pastoral and South West regions, I ask:

- (a) how many 'restriction of supply' notices have been issued to-date and for each month for Water Corporation customers;
- (b) how many Water Corporation customers have requested a payment plan;
- (c) how many Water Corporation customers have entered into a payment plan;
- (d) how many Water Corporation customers are still on a payment plan;
- (e) how many Water Corporation customers have been pursued through legal avenues over non-payment of bills;
- (f) how many Water Corporation customers have applied for the Water Assist Scheme; and
- (g) how many Water Assist Scheme applications were approved?

**809. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:**

I refer to the decision to build a kindergarten and pre-primary school in Landsdale and I ask:

- (a) when will this be completed;
- (b) when is it anticipated first enrolments will occur;
- (c) how many children can be accommodated at this site;
- (d) what provision will be made for parking; and
- (e) is the building of this school a stop-gap measure in order to defer or delay the construction of another full K-7 primary school in South Landsdale, and if so, what is the estimated time that construction of a new K-7 primary school can be deferred?

**810. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:**

I refer to your media release in December 2012 entitled *\$60m for four new schools in growing areas* announcing new primary schools for Broome, Baldivis, Golden Bay and Lakelands on the rationale to accommodate rapid growth in these areas, and I ask:

- (a) how does the ostensible levels of growth in those areas compare with those in the suburbs of Landsdale, Madeley and Darch; and
- (b) when was population growth last measured for the northern corridor?

**811. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister representing the Minister for Education:**

- (1) What are the projections of population growth from present to 2015–2016 for the following suburbs:
  - (a) Landsdale;
  - (b) Madeley; and
  - (c) Darch?
- (2) Given these projections, can you advise what arrangements are being made for additional primary school places in these suburbs?

**812. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Emergency Services:**

I refer to your commitment to enact laws to address the risks of fire-fighters developing cancer and I ask, have those laws been drafted:

- (a) if so, when will they be introduced into Parliament; and
- (b) is it intended that amendments to existing Workers Compensation laws will be the vehicle through which you will meet your election commitment?

**813. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Emergency Services:**

Can the Minister please advise, for each local government authority in the financial year 2012–2013:

- (a) how much money was raised under the Emergency Services Levy (ESL); and
- (b) the expenditure from ESL funds in each of those local government authorities?

**814. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Environment:**

I refer to the then Minister for Emergency Services election commitment in February 2013 to improve fire fighting appliance safety features and I ask:

- (a) does this commitment also apply to Department of Environment and Conservation (DEC) vehicles; and:
  - (i) if yes to (a), how many DEC appliances need safety upgrades;
  - (ii) what is the timetable for these upgrades; and
  - (iii) what interim measures are being taken to ensure DEC fire-fighter safety?

**815. Ms M.M. Quirk to the Minister for Environment:**

Have there been any modifications made to the Department of Environment and Conservation fire fighting appliances since November 2012 and:

- (a) if so what modifications and to what proportion of the fleet have they been made to; and
- (b) if not, why not?
