- (1) Is the Minister aware, that as a result of a decision by the Department of Education not to proceed to develop schools on land reserved for that purpose in the City of Swan, in Dayton and Brabham, that the City of Swan increased development contributions to cover the costs of recreation space which otherwise would have been shared between the contribution of the Department of Education and the City of Swan for shared open space attached to schools?
- (2) Does the Minister agree that landowners should be forced to pay more for infrastructure that the Department of Education had committed to contribute to?
- (3) Is this a breakdown in the planning relationship between the Department of Planning and the Department of Education?
