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**1. Greater Fremantle Area — Planning and Development** (*Notice given 11 June 2013, amended 18 March 2014*)

That this House requests the Metropolitan Redevelopment Authority to prioritise the coordination and management of the planning and development of the greater Fremantle area, including all of North Fremantle.

**2. Gender Pay Gap — Pay Equity Inquiry** (*Notice given 11 June 2013*)

Hon Alanna Clohesy: To move –

That the Legislative Council notes that Western Australia continues to have the widest gender pay gap in Australia and calls on the Government to conduct a pay equity inquiry as a matter of urgency and use the recommendations of that inquiry to formulate a two-year strategy to close the gender pay gap in Western Australia.

**3. Psychiatric Hospitals — Patient Protection** (*Notice given 11 June 2013*)

Hon Sally Talbot: To move –

That this House notes the findings of the Victorian Mental Illness Awareness Council, that 45 per cent of women who are inpatients in psychiatric hospitals in that state are sexually assaulted while an inpatient, and calls on the Government to take urgent action to —

- (a) establish the extent of similar problems in Western Australian psychiatric hospitals; and
- (b) protect women in Western Australian psychiatric hospitals from sexual assault.
