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**1. Amnesty International Report**

Hon Robin Chapple to move —

That in light of the Amnesty International Report, *There is always a brighter future: Keeping Indigenous kids in the community out of detention in Western Australia*, the Legislative Council address what should be done to address the 23 recommendations contained in the report.

Hon Simon O'Brien to move —

- (a) expresses its dismay that the community is set to lose the benefits and amenity of the High Road (Riverton) Hotel;
- (b) while respecting the right of any commercial entity to pursue profit, invite Coles' management to also consider the responsibilities a major corporate entity has to the communities in which it operates; and
- (c) requests Coles reconsider its plans to demolish the hotel.
