POLICE ACT AMENDMENT (GRAFFITI) BILL 1997

A BILL FOR

AN ACT to amend the Police Act 1892.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be referred to as the *Police Act Amendment* (*Graffiti*) *Act 1997*.

5 Commencement

2. This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

- **3.** In this Act the *Police Act 1892^** is referred to as the principal Act.

New section 65A

4. The principal Act is amended by inserting after section 65 the following —

Carrying graffiti instruments

- **65A.** (1) Any person who, between sunset and sunrise, without lawful excuse
 - (a) in a public place; or
 - (b) a place on which the person is trespassing or has entered without invitation,

carries or has on or about his person or in his possession any instrument or thing —

- (c) capable of being used to cause damage to property where such damage could consist of graffiti; or
- (d) of a class prescribed by regulation,

commits an offence.

Penalty: A fine not exceeding \$500.

(2) Every such instrument or thing shall, on conviction of the offender, become forfeited to the Crown.
