[The *Debts Recovery Act 1830*]  
[Adopted by *Imperial Acts Adopting Act 1836*];
  - (d) 2 & 3 Vict. c. 60 (1839)  
[The *Debts Recovery Act 1839*]  
[Adopted by *Imperial Acts Adopting Act 1844*];
  - (e) 11 Geo. IV & 1 Will. IV c. 40  
[The *Executors Act 1830*]  
[Adopted by *Imperial Acts Adopting Act 1836*];
  - (f) 11 Geo. IV & 1 Will. IV c. 65  
[The *Infants' Property Act 1830*]  
[Adopted by *Imperial Acts Adopting Act 1836*].
- (2) In respect of each Imperial Act referred to in subsection (1), the *Interpretation Act 1984* Part V applies as if a reference in that Part to the repeal of a written law or to the repeal of an enactment were a reference to the repeal of the Imperial Act.
