5 After section 55(4) the following subsection is inserted —

“

(4a) Although a conviction is not recorded and no
punishment is imposed, the offender is deemed to have
been convicted for the purpose of the application of
10 section 401(4) of *The Criminal Code* to the sentencing
of the offender for another offence.

”.

4. Section 189 amended

After section 189(8)(d) the following paragraph is inserted —

(e) the obligation of a Court to impose a sentence
of imprisonment or detention under
section 401(4) of *The Criminal Code*.

”.
