An Act to amend the Agricultural Produce Commission Act 1988.

The Parliament of Western Australia enacts as follows:

s. 1

1 **1. Short title**

2 This is the *Agricultural Produce Commission Amendment*
3 *Act 2021*.

4 **2. Commencement**

5 This Act comes into operation as follows —

6 (a) sections 1 and 2 — on the day on which this Act
7 receives the Royal Assent;

8 (b) the rest of the Act — on the day after that day.

9 **3. Act amended**

10 This Act amends the *Agricultural Produce Commission*

26 **responsibility for agricultural produce to existing**
27 **producers' committee**

- 28 (1) Subject to subsection (2), a producer or producers of
29 agricultural produce, or a body representing the
30 interests of such producers, may request the

- 1 Commission to conduct a poll for the purpose of
2 allocating responsibility for the agricultural produce to
3 an existing producers' committee.
- 4 (2) A request cannot be made under subsection (1) unless
5 the producers' committee has given its written approval
6 to the request being made.
- 7 (3) A request made under subsection (1) must —
8 (a) be made in writing; and
9 (b) specify the producers' committee and the
10 additional agricultural produce for which it is
11 proposed to have responsibility; and
12 (c) specify the objects sought to be effected by
13 allocating responsibility for the additional
14 agricultural produce to the producers'
15 committee; and
16 (d) attach the producers' committee's written
17 approval to the request being made.
- 18 (4) The Commission must publish notice of a proposal to
19 allocate responsibility for agricultural produce to an
20 existing producers' committee.
- 21 (5) A notice referred to in subsection (4) must —
22 (a) be published in the manner directed by the
23 Minister; and
24 (b) specify the name or names of the producer or
25 producers, or body, that made the request; and
26 (c) specify the producers' committee and the
27 additional agricultural produce for which it is
28 proposed to have responsibility; and

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- 1 (d) explain in simple terms the objects sought to be
2 effected by the proposal; and
3 (e) invite submissions from producers who may be
4 affected by the proposal.
- 5 (6) In performing its functions under this Division, the
6 Commission must have regard to any submissions
7 made to it under subsection (5)(e).

8 **11B. Polls to allocate responsibility for produce to**
9 **existing producers' committee**

- 10 (1) If a request is made under section 11A(1) to conduct a
11 poll for the purpose of allocating responsibility for
12 agricultural produce to an existing producers'
13 committee, the Commission must, subject to
14 subsections (2) and (4), conduct the poll.
- 15 (2) The Commission must not conduct the poll if, in its
16 opinion, allocating responsibility for the agricultural
17 produce to the producers' committee would be
18 materially to the financial detriment of a producer or
19 producers of the agricultural produce.
- 20 (3) For the purposes of subsection (2), the Commission
21 may invite any producer who in the opinion of the
22 Commission has an interest in the matter to attend
23 meetings of the Commission.
- 24 (4) The Commission must not conduct the poll unless the
25 producer or producers, or body, that requested the poll
26 deposits with the Commission such sum as is
27 determined by the Commission as the reasonable costs
28 of the poll.

- 1 (5) If the Commission resolves to allocate responsibility
2 for agricultural produce to the producers' committee,
3 any money paid to the Commission under
4 subsection (4) must be repaid by the producers'
5 committee out of the funds of the producers'
6 committee to the producer or producers, or body, that
7 made the deposit under that subsection.

8 **11C. Allocating responsibility for agricultural produce to**
9 **existing producers' committee**

- 10 (1) The Commission must not allocate responsibility for
11 agricultural produce to an existing producers'
12 committee unless —
13 (a) the Commission has —
14 (i) complied with section 11A(4) and (5);
15 and
16 (ii) conducted a poll under section 11B
17 among the producers of the agricultural
18 produce;
19 and
20 (b) the poll is in favour of the proposal.
- 21 (2) Even if the Commission has complied with
22 sections 11A(4) and (5) and 11B(1) to (4), the
23 Commission may refuse to allocate responsibility for
24 the agricultural produce to the producers' committee if
25 the Commission considers that, having regard to the
26 circumstances of the case, it is not desirable or
27 practicable to do so.
- 28 (3) If the Commission resolves to allocate responsibility
29 for agricultural produce to the producers' committee,
30 then on a day specified by the Commission in a notice
31 under section 11D(1) the producers' committee

4 **produce to existing producers' committee and**
5 **appointing additional members**

6 (1) If the Commission resolves to allocate responsibility
7 for agricultural produce to an existing producers'
8 committee, the Commission must by notice published
9 in the *Gazette* —

10 (a) specify the producers' committee and the
11 agricultural produce for which it is allocated
12 responsibility; and

13 (b) specify the day on which the producers'
14 committee commences to have responsibility
15 for the agricultural produce; and

16 (c) invite nominations from among the producers
17 of the agricultural produce for appointment to
18 the producers' committee.

19 (2) After receiving nominations the Commission —

20 (a) must decide how many members, in addition to
21 the current number of members, there is to be
22 on the producers' committee; and

23 (b) if it is of the opinion that a poll of the producers
24 of the agricultural produce should be held to
25 elect the members, must conduct a poll.

26 (3) A person is not eligible to stand at a poll under this
27 section to elect members of a producers' committee
28 unless the person is qualified to be appointed to the
29 producers' committee in relation to the agricultural
30 produce in question.

- 1 (4) Subject to subsection (5), a person elected at a poll
2 under this section to be a member of a producers'
3 committee must be appointed by the Commission to be
4 a member of the producers' committee.
- 5 (5) The Commission must not appoint a person under this
6 section to be a member of a producers' committee
7 unless the Commission is of the opinion that the person
8 is qualified to be so appointed in relation to the
9 agricultural produce in question.

10 **Division 3 — Appointment of non-producers to**
11 **producers' committees**

12 **11E. Appointment of non-producers to producers'**
13 **committees**

- 14 (1) A producers' committee may nominate for
15 appointment to that producers' committee a person
16 who would not be eligible to stand at a poll under
17 section 11 or 11D to elect members of the producers'
18 committee.
- 19 (2) The Commission may appoint a person nominated
20 under subsection (1) by a producers' committee to be a
21 member of the producers' committee if —
- 22 (a) the Commission is of the opinion that it would
23 be desirable and practicable to do so; and
- 24 (b) the Commission is of the opinion that the
25 person has experience relevant to the
26 producers' committee's functions; and
- 27 (c) after the person is appointed, the majority of
28 members of the producers' committee would be
29 producers of the agricultural produce for which
30 the producers' committee has responsibility.

12 **19C. Terms used**

13 In this Division —

14 *charge* means a charge imposed under this Act;

15 *compliance purposes* means the following purposes —

- 16 (a) monitoring compliance with a requirement
17 under this Act to pay or collect a charge;
- 18 (b) monitoring compliance with a requirement
19 under this Act to give information, or produce a
20 record, relating to the production, processing,
21 sale or purchase of agricultural produce or the
22 payment or collection of a charge;
- 23 (c) monitoring compliance with a requirement in a
24 notice under section 13;
- 25 (d) investigating a suspected contravention of a

- 24 (1) An authorised officer may, for compliance purposes,
- 25 do 1 or more of the following —
- 26 (a) direct a relevant person —
- 27 (i) to give any information as is required;
- 28 or
- 29 (ii) to answer a question put to the person;

- 1 (b) direct a relevant person to produce to the
2 authorised officer a relevant record in the
3 person's custody or under the person's control.
- 4 (2) An authorised officer may examine and make a copy of
5 a record produced in response to a direction under
6 subsection (1)(b), and retain the record for as long as is
7 reasonably necessary.
- 8 (3) A direction under subsection (1)(a) —
- 9 (a) may be given orally or in writing; and
- 10 (b) must specify the time at, or within which, the
11 information or answer must be given to the
12 authorised officer; and
- 13 (c) may require that the information or answer —
- 14 (i) be given orally or in writing; or
- 15 (ii) if it is directed to be given in writing, be
16 given by means specified in the
17 direction; or
- 18 (iii) be verified by statutory declaration.
- 19 (4) A direction under subsection (1)(b) —
- 20 (a) must be in writing given to the person required
21 to produce the record; and
- 22 (b) must specify the time at, or within which, the
23 record is to be produced; and
- 24 (c) may require that the record be produced to the
25 authorised officer —
- 26 (i) at a place specified in the direction; and
- 27 (ii) by the means specified in the direction.

1 **19E. Failure to comply with directions**

2 A person must not without reasonable excuse fail to
3 comply with a direction given to the person under
4 section 19D(1).

5 Penalty: a fine of \$1 000.

6 **19F. Self-incrimination not an excuse**

7 (1) An individual is not excused from complying with a
8 direction under section 19D(1) to provide information
9 or answer questions, or to produce a record, on the
10 ground that the information, answer or record might
11 incriminate the individual or make the individual liable
12 to a penalty.

13 (2) However, any information or answer provided, or
14 record produced, by an individual in compliance with a
15 direction under section 19D(1) is not admissible in
16 evidence in any proceedings against the individual
17 other than proceedings for perjury or an offence against
18 section 19G(2).
