Section 5 of the principal Act is amended —

- (a) in subsection (1), by deleting "The Governor" and substituting the following
 - " Subject to subsection (1A), the Governor ";
- (b) by inserting after subsection (1) the following —

(1A) Any proclamation made under this section relating to —

- (a) the whole, or any part, of the land; or
- (b) any buildings, or enclosures, on the land,

described in Schedule 3,

is invalid and of no effect.

(c) by inserting after subsection (2) the following —

(3) The proclamation made under this section and published in the *Government Gazette* dated Friday 17 March 2000 is revoked.
