

Please see below from Hon John Quigley MLA - Attorney General regarding the answer provided to Supplementary Question A4 –

As previously advised, the invoices are subject to legal professional privilege, and they are confidential. The privilege is not that of the State and so I am not able to determine what redactions are required in order to remove all of the privileged material or determine whether anything that remains is confidential. Accordingly, even if the privileged information was to be removed, anything that remained would continue to be subject to confidentiality that is not the State's to waive, but rather a private individual and therefore the invoices cannot be provided.
