Question 1:



I refer to page 458 and the reconciliation relating to major functional transfers and accounting policy changes and I ask the Minister to provide a detailed breakdown of the \$33.468m used to transfer the Office of Energy to the newly created Department of Finance, public Utilities Office?

Answer:

The amount of \$33.468 million recorded on page 458 relates to the estimated actual total cost of service of the Office of Energy at 31 March 2012. It is not the cost to transfer the Office of Energy to the Department of Finance's Public Utilities Office. The breakdown of the estimated total cost of services for the Office of Energy is detailed below.

These figures include wages and salaries, superannuation and redundancy payments.

(a) Total FTE: 3216.5

Trainees: 93.0 Apprentices: 111.0 Graduate: 35.4
