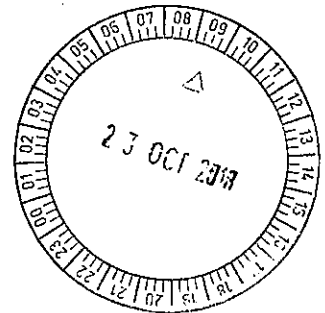

Western Australian Electoral Commission

The Committee asked:

1. For each matter that had an impact in 2017-18, how much was spent on
