#### Hon Diane Evers asked:

[Yarloop bushfire clean-up] I am also interested in the recouped \$5 million from Alcoa. How was that decided?

#### Answer:

Following the January 2016 bushfires, Alcoa of Australia Limited agreed to the State Government managing the clean-up of all fire affected properties, which included 58 properties owned by Alcoa. This ensured that the remediation and recovery works were undertaken professionally and consistently across the region, whilst utilising resources (contractors/equipment etc.) already present in the area. Alcoa agreed to reimburse the State Government for all costs associated with the remediation of its properties, excluding State Government overheads.

The final recoup of funds was agreed with Alcoa and paid to the State in June 2017.

## Hon Peter Collier asked:

No; the public sector, so I will put them in for the Public Sector Commissioner. That is fine. Just on DPC, can I get the number of FTE for DPC from the day the government took office and the breakdown of public servants and TOGs on that day and again as of today—a comparison between the two?

#### Answer:

- The FTE as at 11 March 2017 consist 95.8 FTEs employed under a Term of Government contract and 362.9 FTEs under general conditions of employment.
- The FTE as at 19 October 2017 consist 115.2 FTEs employed under a Term of Government contract and 347.0 FTEs under general conditions of employment.

#### Hon Martin Aldridge asked:

I turn to page 64 which is headed "Outcomes and Key Effectiveness Indicators". On page 65 under "Services and Key Efficiency Indicators" is the administration of executive government services. I have complained before at estimates hearings that the administration of entitlements for members and former members of Parliament clumsily falls under this title of "Administration of Executive Government Services" because we are not executive government. But when I look at the provision that is made for the cost of entitlements per member of Parliament and the cost of support provided per member of Parliament on page 65 and extrapolate that over the 95 of us, I reach a figure of \$39.615 million. That equates to 32 per cent, or roughly one-third, of the total service cost from that division, or 26.5 per cent of the total cost of services for the department, so not a small number by any stretch. When it comes to outcomes and key effectiveness indicators on page 64, how is it that the department measures its performance in relation to the discharge of 26.5 per cent of its services provided to members of Parliament?

#### Answer:

The Key Effectiveness Indicators (KEIs) with relation to Members of Parliament is calculated as part of a wider formula that measures overall effectiveness with relation to service one. The Department of the Premier and Cabinet is investigating different KEI measurement options for 2018/19.
