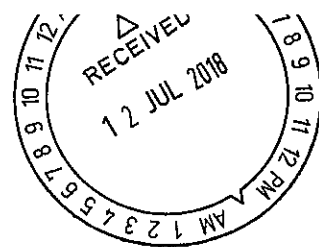

SUPPLEMENTAL QUESTIONS

Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety

Hon Michael Michin asked:

- D1. Perhaps by way of supplementary information, I could be provided with a breakdown of the staffing levels in various areas of responsibility, for example, EnergySafety. What are the number of FTEs assigned as inspectors and the like and the staffing levels for each of those, including the Building Commission—how many are inspectors, how many are involved in doing backroom work and policy work? Likewise with industrial relations, WorkSafe and the other areas.

Hon ALANNAH MacTIERNAN: In relation to WorkSafe?

Hon MICHAEL MISCHIN: All of them, thank you—industrial relations, EnergySafety, Consumer Protection and Building Commission.

Answer:

- Building and Energy – Inspectors 64.6 FTEs, Other 92.11 FTEs
- Labour Relations – Inspectors 7.55 FTEs, Other 29.95 FTEs
- WorkSafe – Inspectors 85.96 FTEs, Other 19.24 FTEs
- Consumer Protection – Inspectors 48.85 FTEs, Other 162.2 FTEs

(Not including FTE in newly created support teams of Service Delivery and Business Innovation following an internal reorganisation of the Department.)
