I refer to the Questions Prior to the Department of Education's hearing before the Standing Committee on Estimates and Financial Operations on 17 October 2017, which were submitted to the Committee by my office on 9 October 2017.

Following their submission, the Department of Education identified an error in the table attached to the answer to Question 4 asked by Hon Donna Faragher MLC regarding national partnerships. The attached corrected version of the response to Question 4 shows, by means of highlighting, the two cells that have changed.

The previous response, which had been signed and now appears on the Committee's website, showed a funding amount of \$7.63 million for the National School Chaplaincy Program in 2018-19 when it should not have; the amount previously showing has been deleted in the corrected version and the end-date of the agreement amended from 30/6/2019 to 30/6/2018.
