



STANDING COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATION

Inquiry into the Criminal Investigation Amendment Bill 2009

The Standing Committee on Legislation is currently inquiring into the *Criminal Investigation Amendment Bill 2009*, and its policy. The Bill makes amendments to the stop and search powers of the Western Australia Police.

The Committee was due to report its findings on Thursday, 25 March 2010 but has today been granted an extension, by the House, to Thursday, 17 June 2010. Given the controversial nature of the Bill, this extension was sought to give the Committee further time to adequately consider the large volume of evidence it has received.
