Legislation Committee: Criminal Procedure Amendment (Trial by Judge Alone) Bill 2017

The Standing Committee on Legislation has announced an inquiry into the Criminal Procedure Amendment (Trial by Judge Alone) Bill 2017.

The Legislative Council referred the Bill for consideration and report by no later than 12 May 2020, including the power to inquire and report on the policy of the Bill.

The Committee invites submissions from interested persons. A submission must be in writing and may deal with matters relating to the policy, scope, purpose, and structure of the Bill.

Once your submission has been sent to the Committee it is confidential and you should check with the Committee before you disclose it to others. Your submission should also include any requests to:

- appear before the Committee in support of your submission
- keep all or part of your submission private, including if you would like to keep your identity confidential.

Submissions are due by **5pm** on **22 November 2019**.
