Report Eleven (tabled in the House on September 16 2003)

The Committee brings to the attention of the House the following correction to its Eleventh Report. The Report contains an error in Recommendation 5 which appears at pages iii and 22 of the report.

Recommendation 5 proposes statutory amendments to clause 18 of the Higher Education Bill 2003. The error appears in proposed subclause (6)(b).

The correction to Recommendation 5 appears below (with emphasis added indicating the correction):

**Recommendation 5: The Committee recommends that clause 18 of the Higher Education Bill 2003 be amended in the following manner –**

**Page 11, after line 31 - To insert the following –**

“

**(5) A right of access under subsection (4) may be exercised –**

**(a) without notice during ordinary and actual business hours on any day; or**


**(b) after giving written notice of not less than 24 hours if access is to occur at any other time.**

**(6) A requirement under subsection (4) –**

**(a) is to be in writing identifying the form and content of the information or described by reference to a class or type of information that corresponds to that in the requirement; and**

**(b) is to state the purpose of the requirement and require the information to an extent that is proportionate in scope and ~~purpose-~~ content to that purpose.**
