I would like to keep you up to date on the matters pertaining to this development application.

On the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2015, the City of Stirling held their Council meeting and this item was on the Agenda (item 11.2). I have attached Agenda Item 11.2 and the Responsible Report Authority for your information.

At the meeting there were many residents who oppose this development. At agenda Item 11.2 the Officers of the City of Stirling had completed a Responsible Report Authority on this application and the recommendation of this report was that the Council **REJECT** the four storey development proposal. This Responsible Report Authority was accepted and CARRIED at the City of Stirling Council.

This proposed development application still has the opportunity to go ahead as it still has to go to Metro North-West JDAP to be discussed and voted on. We are currently unaware of a date for this.

We would really appreciate your help and assistance with ensuring that this development doesn't go ahead as a four storey development, (we are quite happy with a two storey development) the reasons being as outlined in the Responsible Report Authority carried out by the City of Stirling Officers.
