PETITION

TO THE HONOURABLE PRESIDENT AND MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL OF THE
PARLIAMENT OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED.

We, the undersigned, residents of Riverfarm Road, Kununurra object to the preferred alignment currently proposed for the new Kununurra Heavy Vehicle Route and the chosen site for the construction of the major new bridge over the Ord River, which will be visible from some homes 800 metres away, will rise 17 metres above the water-level (with a total height of 30 metres), will be 480 metres long, and will be lit by light poles some 12 to 18 meters high.

We, the residents will all be greatly affected by the compression braking of heavy vehicles and headlights from all vehicles using the bridge. This area of the Ord River is still in a pristine and natural state and is a breeding ground for many threatened and protected fauna.

We urge the Legislative Council to call on the State Government to reconsider the location of this proposed bridge and Heavy Vehicle Route to further north or south of the residents of Riverfarm Road, Kununurra.
