- (e) of the people currently residing at the facility, how long has each person been there;
- (f) what specialist mental health treatment are these people receiving and who is providing it;
- (g) what follow up is provided to people exiting this facility; and
- (h) how many staff are currently working at the facility?

6809. Ms A.S. Carles to the Minister representing the Minister for Mental Health; Disability Services

With reference to the Fremantle Mental Health Service and the recent suicides of mental health patients being discharged from Alma Street, I ask:

- (a) will the Minister release emergency funding immediately to ensure an adequate supply of beds at Alma Street so that suicidal patients receive appropriate treatment in Fremantle; and
 - (i) if yes, how much emergency funding will the Minister release and when will additional beds be available;
- (b) what strategies will the Minister put in place to ensure that mental health patients in Fremantle make a safe transition from hospital to home; and
- (c) what follow up service is currently provided to mental health patients in Fremantle when they are discharged from Alma Street?

6810. Mr J.M. Francis to the Premier

Regarding the volume of Questions on Notice that have been asked of the Government I ask:

- (a) what was the total number of Questions on Notice received by the Government in:
 - (i) 2007;
 - (ii) 2008 (both prior to and after the State election);
 - (iii) 2009;
 - (iv) 2010; and
 - (v) to date in 2011;
- (b) what is the break-up of these questions per Ministerial portfolio;
- (c) what proportion of these questions have been asked by:
 - (i) government members; and
 - (ii) non-government members; and
- (d) what is the average total cost per question to provide answers to these Questions on Notice, both in terms of hours and actual monetary value?
