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## NON-GOVERNMENT BUSINESS

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### 1. Energy-efficient all-electric homes

Hon Dr Brad Pettitt to move —

That the Legislative Council —

- (a) notes that energy-efficient, all-electric homes can significantly improve occupant health while reducing emissions and running costs;
- (b) acknowledges that social housing tenants often experience hotter conditions in summer, and colder conditions in winter and as a result higher energy bills due to Western Australia's poorly insulated and ageing social housing stock; and
- (c) calls on this Government to do more to support the transition towards energy-efficient housing in Western Australia by:
  - (i) incentivising household batteries, heat pumps, and more energy-efficient building materials for every Western Australian home; and
  - (ii) urgently retrofitting Western Australia's social housing stock with Solar PV and energy efficiency measures to address energy poverty as our climate gets hotter.

### 2. Liquefied Natural Gas emissions

Hon Dr Brad Pettitt to move —

That the Legislative Council —

- (a) notes that a Cornell University peer-reviewed study, published in the journal *Energy Science and Engineering* on 3 October 2024, estimates emissions from conventional and unconventional LNG in the USA over the last 20-years were 33% greater than emissions from coal;
- (b) acknowledges that if emissions from Australian LNG production are similar to global estimates, then gas is no longer a credible transition fuel for Western Australia or our export partners; and
- (c) calls on this Government to immediately pause the approval of any new gas projects until a transparent and independent study of the whole-of-life greenhouse gas emissions, including methane, of Western Australian LNG is commissioned and the results published.
