1056. Hon Dr Brad Pettitt to the Minister for Emergency Services representing the Minister for Environment:

I refer to the McGowan Government's commitment made in February 2019, 'Plan for our Parks' to secure a further five million hectares of new national parks, marine parks and other conservation areas over the next five years. Now, more than three years and eight months on from that commitment, and I ask:

- (a) how many hectares of conservation estate have now been created under the Plan for Our Parks initiative; and
- (b) is the Government on track to achieve the full five million hectares in the next 16 months, by February 2024 as initially promised?

I refer to the comments by Russian leader Vladimir Putin, that he may suspend all commodity supplies to western democracies, and I ask:

- (a) what steps is the Minister taking to ensure Western Australia can supply commodities to fill the possible shortfall created by international events;
- (b) has the Minister investigated the potential for the expansion of the phosphate industry in Western Australia to support local and global food security; and
- (c) has the Minister investigated the potential for the state investment in water infrastructure for the expansion of agriculture in Western Australia to help address global food insecurity?

For each of the financial years 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22, I ask:
