I refer to Senator Pauline Hanson's visit to Western Australia on 29 February 2024, and I ask:

- (a) Was Senator Hanson provided a security detail by the Western Australia Police Force; and

 - (ii) If no, please provide the rationale for why the WA Police Force sent out a text message relating to a Bill that had not yet been passed through Parliament;
- (f) Who decided the wording of the text message:
 - (i) Please detail their job position title; and
- (g) What was the exact total financial cost of sending this text message?
