Hon Dr Steve Thomas: To move —

That this House —

- (a) notes the Government's announcement on 5 November 2021 of a plan for the opening of the State from COVID restrictions called the WA Safe Transition Plan;
- (b) notes the lack of detail in the announced plan and requests the Government table modelling and health advice which shows when Western Australia is predicted to reach 90% vaccination of over 12s for each Local Government Area in the State;
- asks the Government to explain in detail how it will monitor and manage mandated vaccination cohorts and the impacts this will have on business, employees and the economy in both metropolitan and regional Western Australia; and
- (d) notes the constant failings of the Western Australian health system and asks the State Government to explain in detail the preparations they have made to ensure the health system can cope with COVID when it arrives.
