I refer to question on notice No. 7971 asked in the Legislative Assembly on 15 May 2012, regarding the estimated profit to the Rottnest Island Authority (RIA) from the upgraded golf course during the first three years of its operation, the Minister for Tourism said, in part, that a net profit is not expected during the first three years and that 'based on current assumptions, the break-even point occurs in year seven of the proposed ten-year lease period', and ask—
