I refer to the planned development of Sunningdale Primary School in Yanchep, and I ask:

- (a) could the Minister please advise the anticipated enrolments for this school for each of the first five years of operation, with the expected cohorts for each year;
- (b) could the Minister please provide the boundaries of the zoned intake area of this primary school;
- (c) could the Minister please advise the likely locations and construction timeframes of any other primary schools to be constructed in Yanchep;
- (d) could the Minister please advise if any consideration has been made of locating the school near the new sporting facilities at Splendid Park; and
- (e) could the Minister please table any and all advice that has been received from WaterCorp regarding the impact on the mains water pressure and sewerage systems of surrounding residents?

2585. Hon Alison Xamon to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to the land cleared to the west and north of Moorpark Avenue in Yanchep, and I ask:

- (a) could the Minister please advise what dust suppression measures are required for land cleared for new developments in the metropolitan area;
- (b) could the Minister please advise who is responsible for carrying out these dust suppression measures; and
- (c) could the Minister please advise which agency is responsible for monitoring and enforcing that the dust suppression measures are carried out?

2587. Hon Robin Chapple to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy 2030*, specifically the headline strategy “Implement local government waste plans, which align local government waste planning processes with the Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy 2030” (p6), and I ask:

- (a) as the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy 2030* doesn’t mention electronic waste (“e-waste”) specifically, will e-waste remain managed under the *Product Stewardship Act 2011*;
- (b) given that e-waste is often shipped interstate, how will the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy 2030* support existing, local government-supported processors;
- (c) given that local processors remain financially challenged, even with the Community and Industry Engagement program (CIE) grant made available for infrastructure, will the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Strategy 2030* support local processing infrastructure in favour of transporting waste for processing;
- (d) if yes to (c), in what ways will the strategy support local infrastructure; and
- (e) if no to (c), would the Minister provide a rationale for this decision?
