# **THURSDAY, 1 SEPTEMBER 2011**

#### 1. Meeting of Council

The Council assembled at 10.00am pursuant to Temporary Orders.

The President, Hon Barry House, took the Chair and read prayers.

#### 2. Petitions

Hon Wendy Duncan presented a petition from 22 petitioners requesting the Legislative Council recommend to the Attorney General that he urgently act to ensure that courts are able to use appropriate discretion when sentencing people with a significant mental impairment. (Tabled paper 3655).

Hon Jon Ford presented a petition from 917 petitioners requesting the Legislative Council to support legislation ensuring that a greater share of skilled work for major resource projects is performed in Western Australia. (Tabled paper 3656).

Hon Nigel Hallett presented a petition from 3,918 petitioners requesting the Legislative Council recommend a total ban on commercial gill net fishing in all ocean waters from Albany to Bunbury. (Tabled paper 3657).

The Minister for Finance representing the Treasurer moved, That the Bill be now read a third time.

Bill read a third time and passed.

The Deputy President having counted the House, and there being an absolute majority present, and no dissentient voice, declared the motion carried with the concurrence of an absolute majority.

#### 13. Joint Standing Committee on Audit

The Order of the Day having been read, the Leader of the House, pursuant to notice, moved -

- (1) That pursuant to section 43 of the Auditor General Act 2006
  - (a) a Joint Standing Committee on Audit be established, comprised of four members (including the Chairman) of the Legislative Council Standing Committee on Estimates and Financial Operations and four members of the Legislative Assembly Public Accounts Committee, two of whom from each House support the Government;
  - (b) the Chairman of the Standing Committee on Estimates and Financial Operations will be the Chairman of the Joint Standing Committee; and
  - (c) the Standing Orders of the Legislative Council relating to Standing Committees will be followed as far as they can be applied.
- (2) That the Legislative Assembly be invited to pass a similar resolution.

Debate ensued.

Hon Ken Travers moved, without notice -

To insert after section (1)(a) the following -

the members of the Legislative Council Standing Committee on Estimates and Financial Operations and the Legislative Assembly Public Accounts Committee not appointed to the Joint Standing Committee under section (1)(a) are appointed to the Joint Standing Committee as participating members in accordance with Legislative Council Standing Order 326. The requirement for leave of the committee under Standing Order 326 does not apply to these appointments;

Debate ensued.

Amendment - put and passed.

Debate resumed on the motion, as amended.

Motion, as amended - put and passed.

#### 14. Questions Without Notice

The Parliamentary Secretary representing the Premier tabled documents detailing a contract of employment between the Public Sector Commissioner and Ms Josephine Charlotte Harrison-Ward, in response to a question without notice asked by Hon Sue Ellery. (Tabled paper 3662).

The Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport tabled documents in relation to details of the Public Transport Authority's Smartrider fares and refunds, in response to a question without notice asked by Hon Ken Travers. (Tabled paper 3663).

The President reported the receipt of Message No. 201 from the Legislative Assembly forwarding the Bill for concurrence.

The Leader of the House representing the Minister for Sport and Recreation moved, That the Bill be now read a first time.
