#### 5. State Coroner's Findings into Deaths by Self Harm

Hon Robyn McSweeney: To move on the next day of sitting -

That given the serious issues raised in Alistair Hope's findings into the deaths by self harm of 22 people from the Kimberley area of Western Australia (*WA State Coroner's Record of Investigation into Death Ref No. 37/07; February 2008*), this House calls on the State Government to urgently address the following issues -

- (a) Child Protection;
- (b) Drug and Alcohol Abuse;
- (c) Health;
- (d) Housing;
- (e) Education;
- (f) Youth;
- (g) Law and Order; and
- (h) Employment.

#### 6. Fair Employment Advocate - Helen Creed

Motion No. 61 having been called, Hon Norman Moore continued his introductory remarks in moving the following motion -

- (1) That the Minister for Child Protection representing the Minister for Employment Protection table, within three days of this order, the following documents in relation to the appointment of Ms Helen Creed as Fair Employment Advocate -
  - (a) advice provided by the Department of Consumer and Employment Protection to the Director General of the Department of Premier and Cabinet; and
  - (b) the recommendation of the Director General of the Department of Premier and Cabinet to the Minister for Public Sector Management.
- (2) If the House is not in session and sitting when the documents the subject of the order are due to be tabled, the Minister for Child Protection is to transmit the documents to the Clerk of the Legislative Council and the documents are to be taken to have been laid before the House.

Debate ensued.

Before I put the motion, I propose to delete the words "the Minister for Child Protection representing" in paragraph (1) and to replace the words "the Minister for Child Protection" in paragraph (2) with the words "the Minister for Employment Protection" to reflect recent changes in ministerial portfolios, so that the motion will read -

- (1) The Minister for Employment Protection table, within three days of this order, the following documents in relation to the appointment of Ms Helen Creed as Fair Employment Advocate -
  - (a) advice provided by the Department of Consumer and Employment Protection to the Director General of the Department of Premier and Cabinet; and
  - (b) the recommendation of the Director General of the Department of Premier and Cabinet to the Minister for Public Sector Management.
- (2) If the House is not in session and sitting when the documents the subject of the order are due to be tabled, the Minister for Employment Protection is to transmit the documents to the Clerk of the Legislative Council and the documents are to be taken to have been laid before the House.
