6408. Mr P.A. Katsambanis to the Minister for Police; Road Safety:

I refer to Operation TIDE, and ask:

- (a) as of 9 September 2020 how many police officers have been seconded to COVID-19 duties; and
- (b) On what date did Operation TIDE reach its full strength of 400 police officers?

6409. Mr D.C. Nalder to the Treasurer; Minister for Finance; Aboriginal Affairs; Lands:

I refer to your response provided on 6 August 2019 on the government's total cost of intrastate airfares for 2018-19 (to 31 May 2019) which totalled \$26,977,112, and ask:

- (a) How many flights in total does this represent;
- (b) How many flight paths are there in regional Western Australia and how many flights were taken on each regional flight path during this period; and
- (c) What was the total spend on each flight path during this period?

6410. Mr D.T. Redman to the Minister for Tourism; Racing and Gaming; Small Business; Defence Issues; Citizenship and Multicultural Interests:

I refer to government efforts to promote tourism in Western Australia (WA), and ask:

- (a) Has the WA government secured any deals, contracts or Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) with online booking platforms or Online Travel Agents (OTA) as they are sometimes described:
 - (i) If yes, with which organisations;
 - (ii) If yes, is the Minister aware that many of these online travel agents have high commissions and much of their revenue goes overseas; and
 - (iii) If yes, what is the nature of these relationships, and for what reason is the government doing it; and
- (b) Is any part of the government's tourism promotion strategy utilising the services of an OTA:
 - (i) If yes, can the Minister describe the purpose of the inclusion of an OTA in the government's strategy?

6411. Mr P.A. Katsambanis to the Minister for Police; Road Safety:

I refer to police covert hoon cameras, and ask:

- (a) For each of the years 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 (to date) how many new police covert hoon cameras have been purchased;
- (b) Of the most recent purchase of covert hoon cameras what was the average cost of each unit; and
- (c) Have any covert hoon cameras been retired or decommissioned since 2013?

I refer to Public Transport Authority (PTA) train stations on the north metropolitan line, and ask:

- (a) How many parking bays are there at the Edgewater, Whitfords, Greenwood and Warwick train stations;

- (b) For each of the train stations listed in (a) in what year were additional parking bays last built; and
- (c) In what year was the infrastructure at these four train stations last audited by the PTA?

I refer to the Western Australian Police Force, and ask:

- (a) How many assaults on police officers have there been in 2020 (to date);
- (b) For the years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 (to date) what was the average number of sick days for police officers;
- (c) For the years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 (to date) how many chaplains did the Western Australian Police Force have; and
- (d) How many police officers have exited the force in the years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 (to date)?
