Hon Dr Steve Thomas: To move —

That this House notes the failure of the Minister for Agriculture and Food to support the agricultural industry in Western Australia, especially the traditional agricultural sector that delivers over 90% of our production, and notes in particular the Minister's apparent —

- (a) opposition to live export;
- (b) opposition to genetically modified crops;
- (c) opposition to the use of glyphosate;
- (d) failure to find a real solution to the impending farm labour shortage crisis;
- (e) failure to control invasive weeds and pests, noting the recent Auditor General's report;
- (f) victim blaming approach to farm invasion protection for farmers; while at the same time her
- (g) failure to hold anyone to account for the mass cattle deaths on Yandeyarra and Noonkanbah stations.
