I refer to a recent media statement from the Minister for Corrective Services dated, Monday 5 May 2008, entitled 'New Scheme for Young Offenders in the Goldfields', and the Minister's response to question without notice No. 1455, and I ask -

- (1) When will the Kimberley Response Task Force report its recommendations on sentencing options, diversionary programs for youth and supervision of juveniles?
- (2) Is the Government planning to expand the Youth Regional Justice Services, similar to those in the Goldfields and Geraldton, to the Kimberley?
- (3) If yes to (2), when will they be operational?
- (4) If no to (2), when does the Minister expect young offender strategies will be introduced in the Kimberley?
